About the Initiative

Countries in Africa and the United States are home to many heritage sites rooted in the culture and identity of various communities which are facing increasing and uneven climate risks. Therefore, there is a renewed effort to not only promote climate policy and research that ensure the protection of heritage and tradition but to leverage the potentials of heritage for climate actions. The initiative is led by ICOMOS EPWG representatives from the United States and the Africa region, to support intergenerational exchanges critical to safeguarding and promoting heritage. The working group will comprise three cross-disciplinary emerging professional members and a mentor each from the U.S. and the African region. The group will meet twice in 2022, in April and October, with the first convening taking place on April 25. Emerging Professional members will be recruited through Expression of Interest (EOI), which will be disseminated to various networks.
